Motion was made that the minutes from the previous meeting be corrected to read that T. Davis voted no on the adoption of the 2005 Sewage Budget. Motion G. Guenther, seconded R. Vaccarello, motion carried by all present.

Tammy Boice was present to update Council on the Web page, also to list Borough Office hours and to add a frequently asked questions section, such as schedule of events, who to contact for building and sewage permits, recycle bins etc. Council is to compile a list for the February meeting. Scott Chermak was present to have the Pa Uniform Construction Code: Municipal Election Form filled out, signed by President Vaccarello and also to amend the UCC ordinance from #2004-1 to 2005-1. Scott is to get with Marion about the fees and permit paperwork so the Borough can start to issue them and collect the fees by the end of February...

Tax Collector for Amusement Tax needs to be appointed before Spring 2005. Also the New Code Book should be discussed before the February 7<sup>th</sup> meeting. Everyone should review their copy of the Code Book. There will be a meeting January 24<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm for review. Eric Hilliard will be asked to attend.

Council discussed checking into one Garbage hauler for the Borough. Doug is to make some phone calls to check on collection days and amount per household. If a change is made the Borough will need an ordinance on the trash collection. Police Chief C. Tatton requested permission to purchase a Breath Tester for DUI stops and a Window Tint Meter, motion BJ Fediaczko, seconded R Vaccarello, no G Guenther all others present voted yes.

Minute books from 1873-1900 are to be donated to the Historical Society. Mary Harmon is to check the cost for rebinding the books and to have them put on a CD and present the amount to Council at the February meeting.

Motion was made to pay the bills by R. Vaccarello and seconded by D. Trimble, all present voted yes.

The Sewage meeting will be held Jan 19 at 7:00pm, the next Council meeting will be February 7<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 pm. No further business appearing at hand, a motion for adjournment was made and carried by all present
