

April 4, 2005

The regular meeting of the Prospect Borough Council was called to order by President Vaccarello with the Salute to the Flag. The following Council members were present, President Vaccarello, D. Trimble, R. Vaccarello, G. Guenther, B.J. Fediaczko, Mayor Butler. I. Davis and G. Dalton were not present.

Motion was made by D. Trimble and seconded by R. Vaccarello to approve the minutes from the last meeting with the correction that G. Guenther made the motion to pay the bills not N. Vaccarello.

The Police reports for March were presented with 120 hours worked and 671 miles patrolled. There were 5 complaints, 4 for ATV's, 1 for paraphernalia, thefts 4, 3 radios taken from Prospect Auto Sales and 1 radio from Fair Ground Auto. 5 speeding citations and 1 expired inspection. The State Police responded to 6 calls.

Mark Sentell from In-Synch Systems was present to talk to Council about a system for record keeping and the ability to contact other areas on wants and warrants for the Police Department. It would allow the Officer to have contact to other areas from his Police car and can also print citations. It will keep our Police Officer up to date on all State regulations and will automate the reports that are required by the State. The Borough can receive a grant to help with the expense.

The Parks committee reports that it is applying for a grant to help build a wheelchair ramp and to purchase 2 wheelchair accessible picnic tables.

A bid was approved by Council for repairs to Borough Streets. Also the Street Committee will check to see if a speed limit sign on the Griffith property can be moved. Also, the stop sign at Kennedy Rd needs replaced.

Jeremy Olsen provided information on flow meters and states that flow equalization is ok but the data can be off if we by-pass the tank. Council will look into cross training for Robert Hixson.

The Prospect Borough Planning Commission changed their meetings to 7:30pm on the third Monday of the month.

Motion was made to pay the bills by R. Vaccarello, all present voted yes.

The next Council meeting will be May 2 at 7:00pm. No further business appearing at hand, motion to adjourn was made and carried by all present.
